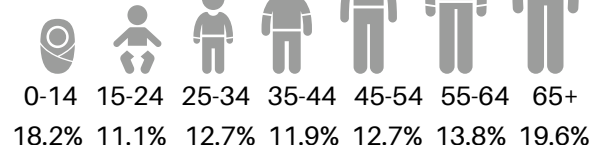

## ROAD NETWORKS

2,518KM of road networks, mixture of A & B class & other roads, no motorways. Between 2010 & 2018 the motor vehicle flow across Cleveland increased by 6% while the vehicle miles covered increased by 8%



## HARTLEPOOL & TEESPORT

Teesport is a major deep sea complex & a national asset for trade. Handling 28 million tonnes per year, the port supports the movement of international imports & exports throughout the North of the UK. Teesvalley is one of the first places to get freeport status.

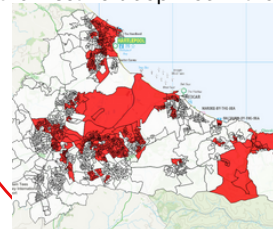
## HIGH HAZARD INDUSTRY
