## To stay warmer this winter follow some of the advice below:



- · Move furniture away from radiators so heat can circulate
- · Curtains should be thick or lined. Close at dusk to keep heat in
- Use heating controls to help manage room temperatures
- Turning the room thermostat down by 1°C can save 10% off your bill
- Set room heat between 18°C and 21°C (64°F and 70°F)
- A room stays warm for 45 minutes after you switch off the heating
- Setting your hot water tank thermostat to 60°C (140°F)
- Place tin foil behind the radiators to put heat back into the room
- Draught proof windows and doors with brush or PVC seals
- Fit a brush or spring flap to letterboxes and cover keyholes

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
