2018/19 Quarterly District Performance Factsheet



The area covered by Redcar & Cleveland lies to the East of Cleveland Fire Authority Area and consists of twenty-two local wards. These wards range from large built up areas to small rural villages which back onto heavy industry. The current population is 136,005* living in 62,492** dwellings.

Specific risks within the District area include: A66, A174, A171, Wilton International Site, Boulby Potash, and PD Ports Teesport.

WHAT NEXT?

- Crews will continue to complete arson audits, working with the Brigade's Community Liaison officer and the council to remove rubbish and increase grass cutting.
- A pilot has been identified in Kirkleatham ward to provide wheelie bin locks following a number of wheelie bin fires in the area;
- Will be working on developing a programme with the coordinator at Tuned In to visit youth groups on a weekly basis.

Exceptionally Good Performance

2018/19 compared to 2017/18

- 39% (25) decrease in Deliberate Primary Fires;
- There were zero injuries or fatalities from an Accidental Dwelling Fires;
- 63% (12) decrease in Accidental Dwelling Fires saving the economy £300,000;
- 37% (39) decrease in Total Primary Fires.

Areas for Improvement

2018/19 compared to 2017/18

- 11% (54) increase in Deliberate Secondary Fires;
- 5% (29) increase in Total Deliberate Fires costing an additional £27,600;
- 1% (6) increase in Total Fire Calls;
- 67% (10) increase in Malicious False Alarm Calls.

What have we achieved?

- We attended Redcar College to discuss joining the Fire Brigade as either retained or whole-time firefighters;
- We have worked as part of an Eston Hills action group to reduce fires and anti-social behaviour in the area;
- A Summer Playscheme at Tuned In for ages 7 to 13 was launched in Redcar to provide activities for the local community. The Brigade joined in at this centre with an event targeting youths with mental health issues and visited weekly to engage with the community.

Home Fire Safety Visits

- We have completed 2,212 Home Fire Safety Visits fitting 1,958 Smoke Alarms across the District;
- We have completed 401 Home Safety Visits to our most vulnerable age range of 65+ (17% of HFSVs completed during period).

Safe and Well Visits

- A successful uptake of Safe & Well Visits with 2,589 undertaken since we commenced delivery of this initiative (October 2016);
- 647 Safe and Well Visits have been undertaken during Quarter 2, 2018/19 (70% of those offered being accepted).

Referrals

- 47x fall referrals;
- 1x alcohol referral;
- 18x loneliness referrals;
- 1x smoking referral.

Provision of equipment

- 15x Push Light;
- 56x Reacher 24;
- 45x Reacher 36.

Grangetown Community Fire Station is located on Slip Road Church Lane/ Trunk Road, Grangetown. It is staffed 24hrs a day, 365 days a year by wholtime firefighters. Contact Grangetown station on: 01642 431210.

Redcar Community Fire Station is located on Trunk Road, Redcar. It is staffed 24hrs a day, 365 days a year by wholtime and retained firefighters. The station has facilities for local people and partners. Contact Redcar station on: 01642 777640

Guisborough Fire Station is located on Park Lane, Guisborough and is staffed by retained firefighters. Contact Guisborough station on: 01287 632242

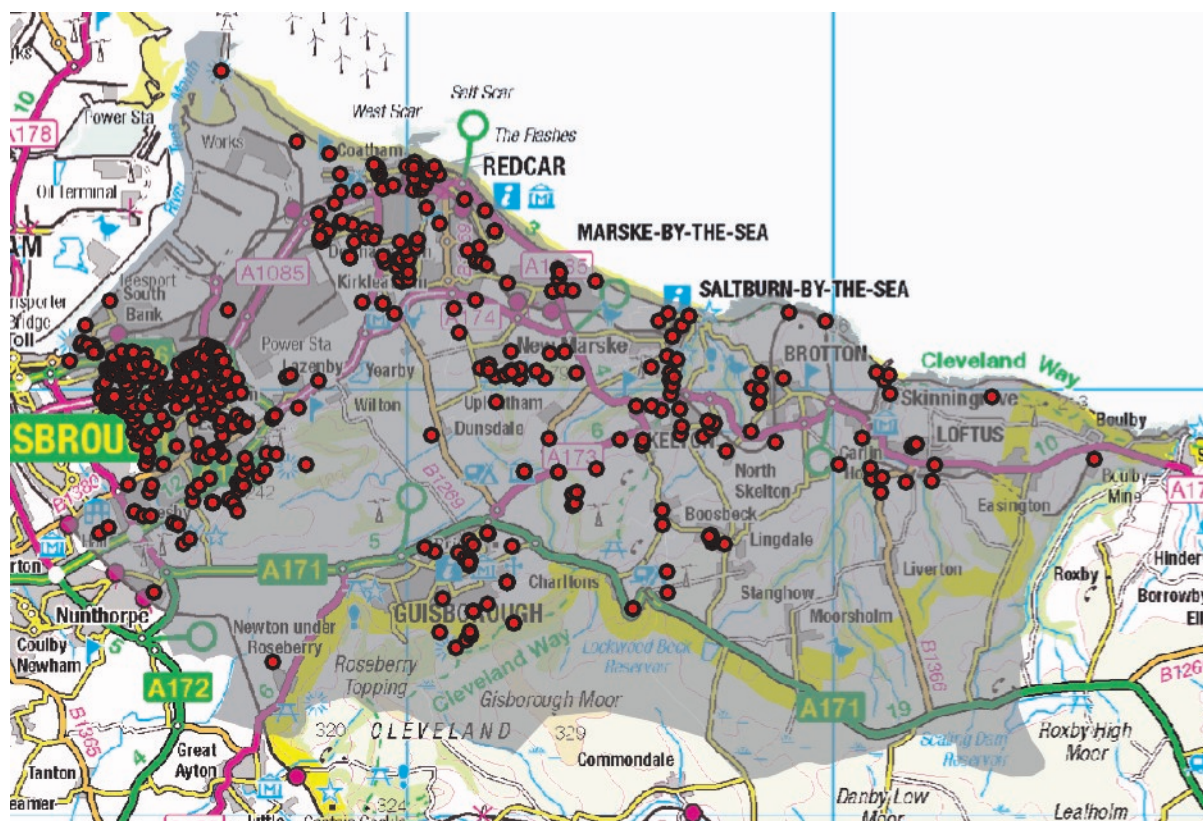
Saltburn Fire Station is located on Leven Street, Saltburn and is staffed by retained firefighters. Contact Saltburn station on: 01287 622076

Deliberate Secondary Fires in Redcar & Cleveland

The map below illustrates the location of Deliberate Secondary Fires in Redcar & Cleveland District for the period April – September 2018.



The wards with the highest proportion of Deliberate Secondary Fire incidents:

- 23% (129) South Bank;
- 20% (111) Grangetown.

The main types were:

- 50% (280) Refuse;
- 47% (263) Grassland.
